






























































"Parents get most of the information about the kids' schedule and activities from your newsletter, so make it short and sweet as they usually get overwhelmed by lengthy ones. Remember to put the most important details, like a calendar of upcoming school events, on the front page where they can't be missed. You can devote a space for some of the kids' major milestones and achievements, as well as the highlights of what they learned in the past month.

It would also be a good idea to encourage the parents to get involved and contribute to the newsletter. If they discovered some useful parenting tips and articles, they can use your newsletter to share it to the rest. Another great addition would be a rundown of your school's menu to let the parents know what their kid is eating. Just get creative and make your newsletter an open and informative space for both kids and guardians! "













My child's behavior is not that different from other children. $^{49\,{\rm respostas}}$






My child has trouble making up his/her mind about things. 49 respostas



My child gets easily distracted from his/her plans. 49 respostas

















My child doesn't notice the effects of his/her actions until it's too late.

















