

- For over twenty years, we have built and maintained strong links with the National University of Ireland NUIG through our Uni4U programme. This was designed to create stronger links between members of the disadvantaged community and the National University. It provides an opportunity for both parents and children to visit and experience college life.
- The university runs a very successful Access Program designed for early school leavers who wish to return to college.
- Our school also works with several agencies to promote school attendance and combat early school leaving in our pupils as they progress to secondary school level.

Musical, Competitions and Games




- Each year the school performs a musical that is staged in the local theatre for both parents and children in the school to attend.

- Our school has developed its own literacy scheme which has helped raise the standards of literacy within the school in the national assessments.
- It has become a training centre to teach and other schools have sent members of their staff in order to see what the school is doing in the promotion of literacy and in our early intervention policies.
- The school has three trained reading recovery teachers. This initiative, from New Zealand, has been proven to be very successful in the promotion of literacy.

Maths Recovery

Our school had three trained Maths Recovery teachers among its staff who have raised numeracy standards and scores throughout the school through targeted interventions from infant classes upwards.
